Day 1 The Retreat, Kigali, Rwanda



Today you will arrive into Kigali, the lively capital city of Rwanda. Please note your arrival flight into Rwanda is not included in your program cost.

Kigali is Rwanda's capital City and stretches across undulating lush hills surrounded by towering mountains, the largest of which is Mount Kigali, rising over 6000 feet above sea level. Kigali is the country's financial, commercial and cultural hub, served by an international airport and featuring a wide range of accommodation options, restaurants and points of interest, including the Kigali Genocide Center, a bustling market and numerous craft shops. With its interesting architecture, energetic streets, meandering boulevards, and green hillsides, Kigali is often referred to as one of most attractive cities in Africa.

At the airport you will be met by your local guide and transferred the short distance to your hotel for the night, the Retreat. Town & Country and The New York Times both recently called The Retreat one of the top new hotels in the world. Fusion Restaurant and its Swahili-inspired bar, located at The Retreat, offer delicious farm-to-table international cuisine, while Heaven Restaurant (reached through the Retreat's "Stairway to Heaven") offers an innovative modern African menu.

Day 2 Sabyinyo Silverback Lodge, Volcanoes National Park, Rwanda



This morning you will meet your driver and guide in your hotel lobby and depart on a moving tour of this remarkable city. One of the most impactful stops as part of this morning's tour will be a visit to the Kigali Genocide Memorial. No visit to Kigali is complete without a visit to this important landmark. Your knowledgeable local guide will tell you all about the history of this turbulent country that ultimately culminated in a genocide that took the lives of over 250,000 of the local Tutsi people. While perhaps not a pleasant conversation it is important to understand these events in order to truly understand Rwanda and its wonderful people.

Following a break for lunch, you will leave Kigali behind and make your way into the lush tropical countryside. The beautiful Sabyinyo Silverback Lodge lies hidden among the foothills of the spectacular Virungas (a chain of volcanoes that lie in what is thought to be the heart of the legendary land of King Solomon's mines). While tomorrow you will embark on your Gorilla trek you have the remainder of today to enjoy one of the other activities offered by the lodge. Surrounded by the tropical forests of Rwanda there are numerous fantastic hiking trails including one which takes you to see the elusive golden monkeys that are endemic to this region.

Day 3
Sabyinyo Silverback Lodge, Volcanoes National Park, Rwanda



This morning you will rise just as the sun is peeking over the horizon and together with your driver you will make your way to the nearby ranger station. Here you will meet with the other travelers who are embarking on today's journey, and with everyone assembled the local rangers will assign everyone into small groups of between 6 and 8. You will be assigned to a group of travelers with a similar fitness and ability level to your own and together you will set off into the jungle in search of these incredible creatures.

Along with a small team of porters who are on hand to assist with carrying any heavy items you may have (think photographic equipment) you will scramble your way along the dense jungle paths as you move deeper into the tropical jungle. After anywhere from 10 minutes to an hour and a half, depending on where the nearest troop is currently residing, you will stumble across what you have been searching for. Weighing up to 500 pounds these gentle giants will look at you with a slight hint of curiosity but will for the most part simply ignore you as they go about their day. You will have around an hour to sit quietly and observe the troop as they interact with one another and the young rambunctiously play all around you.

Following this magical experience, you will then make your way back down the mountainside. Arriving back at the ranger station you will enjoy a short transfer back to your lodge where you then have the remainder of your day at leisure.
