# Day 1: Wednesday, June 1, 2022

## Legendary Lodge, Arusha, Tanzania



Today you will arrive into Arusha, Tanzania. Please note the cost of your international arrival flight is not included in your program cost.

Having been met at the Airport and assisted through immigration, you will enjoy a short transfer to your luxury accommodation for the evening, Legendary Lodge. Here you have the remainder of your day to rest up and relax in preparation for the epic safari adventure that lays ahead.

## Day 2: Thursday, June 2, 2022

### Nyasi Migration Camp, Northern Serengeti, Tanzania



This morning you will enjoy a leisurely breakfast before bidding farewell to Legendary Lodge and meeting your driver for a short transfer to the nearby airport. Here you will hop on board your light aircraft that will transport you high over the rolling plains below and to your home for the next three nights, the incredible Nyasi Migration Camp. Please note this light aircraft flight is included in your program cost.

Arriving at the Serengeti Lamai Airstrip you will be met by your local guide and together set off for Nyasi Migration Camp. Arriving at your remarkable tented camp you will be shown to your beautifully appointed tents and given an orientation tour of this stunning property. The Manager of the camp will explain a few precautions to take during your stay to ensure your safety and wellbeing, as it is worth keeping in mind despite your luxurious surroundings you are in the middle of wild Africa!

You can then enjoy a light lunch before enjoying some time at leisure to relax and unpack. In the late afternoon you will enjoy a casual high tea before setting off on your first safari drive.

During your stay at Nyasi Migration Camp you will have the opportunity to join two safari drives each day. One in the early morning and then another that leaves in the late afternoon and returns shortly after dark.

Depending on the status of the migration your guide may recommend instead going out on one longer safari driver, and perhaps taking a packed picnic lunch with you. This will allow you to cover a huge amount of ground and venture your way into the heart of the Migration!

Returning from the evening game drive you will enjoy a splendid African inspired meal prepared by the lodges talented team of Chefs. After dinner you are welcome to either relax around the communal firepit sipping your choice of beverage as you get to know your fellow travelers, or retire to your room in preparation for the next day's early start.

### Nyasi Migration Camp, Northern Serengeti, Tanzania

Your local guide is an expert in how to get the most out of the migration experience. He will therefore recommend the best course of action for the day, whether that is going out just once for a longer period of time or breaking the day into two shorter safari drives.

Please be sure to chat with your guide if you have any specific interests that you would like to explore while on Safari. These could include interests such as birding or perhaps ask about the possibility of scheduling a nature walk during which you can get up close and personal with the fauna and flora that surrounds your Camp.

Nyasi Migration Camp, Northern Serengeti, Tanzania



Today you will have a last opportunity to experience all the Northern Serengeti has to offer. Get an early start and enjoy breakfast in camp, before heading out to the endless Serengeti plains where you will spend the day drifting through the wildebeest herds and taking in the plethora of wildlife.

## Day 5: Sunday, June 5, 2022

**Singita Sabora Camp, Grumeti Private Game Reserve, Tanzania**



This morning you will enjoy a leisurely breakfast before your guide drives you the short distance back to the nearby airstrip. Here you will board your light aircraft that will take you South into the central Serengeti region. Please note this flight is included in your program cost.

Landing at Singita's airstrip you will be met by your local guide and together make your way to Sabora Tented Camp. This newly refurbished luxury tented Camp is set in 350,000 acres of protected wilderness in Singita Grumeti, which provides travelers with a front-row seat to some of the most prized game viewing on the continent – including of course the Great Migration.

Having checked in, enjoyed lunch, and taken a few hours to relax you will depart on an afternoon safari drive that will introduce you to this remarkable reserve. From rolling grasslands where giraffe and elephant meander in peace, to riverine woodlands where shy creatures suddenly appear from lush foliage; and from rocky outcrops favored by big cats to hidden valleys where large herds of antelope roam and graze, each game drive traverses landscapes that are as rich in scenery as they are in wildlife.

And when the sun dips on the horizon, bringing the day to a close with a brightly painted sky, idyllic sundowner stops in exclusive settings encapsulate the safari experience. Accompanied by a cool

evening breeze and the beauty of the clear night sky above, the tranquil journey back to the lodge often reveals the elusive magic of nocturnal Africa.

## Day 6: Monday, June 6, 2022

Singita Sabora Camp, Grumeti Private Game Reserve, Tanzania



This morning you will wake shortly after sunrise and make your way to communal area of the Camp. Here you will enjoy a quick cup of tea or coffee before setting off in your open 4x4 safari vehicle in search of the incredible wildlife of the Grumeti game reserve.

As your trip coincided with the Great Migration passing through this incredible eco-system, your expert guide will teach you all about this incredible wildlife phenomena as you while away the day in the midst of the massed herds. Depending on the exact location of the migration, your guide may take you south to the Grumeti River. Here dramatic scenes can unfold as the millions of wildebeest, Zebra and other animals making their way North risk the perilous crossing. Hungry crocodiles, big cats, and other predators are never far away.

## Day 7: Tuesday, June 7, 2022

Singita Sabora Camp, Grumeti Private Game Reserve, Tanzania



Today you will continue your exploration of this world-renowned ecosystem. If you are feeling more active be sure to ask your guide about embarking on a guided nature walk. He, along with a highly trained local tracker will accompany you as you track animals on foot through the wilderness and explore the magnificent plants and landscapes around you.

## Day 8: Wednesday, June 8, 2022

Mwiba Lodge, Mwiba Wildlife Reserve, Tanzania



This morning you will make your way back to the nearby airstrip and continue your journey South to Mwiba Wildlife Reserve. Please note this flight is included in your program cost.

Mwiba Lodge is perfectly located in the heart of a 129,530-acre private game reserve overlooking a dramatic rocky gorge on the Arugusinyai River. Over the next four days you will enjoy a wide range of incredible experiences ranging from cultural interactions with the local tribespeople, to inspirational bush walks and fascinating night drives that always deliver the unexpected.

## Day 9: Thursday, June 9, 2022

Mwiba Lodge, Mwiba Wildlife Reserve, Tanzania



Today you will enjoy a truly one in a lifetime experience. With Mwiba situated south of the Serengeti, on the escarpment above Lake Eyasi, you will have the incredible privilege of being allowed into the lives of the local Hadzabe tribe in an authentic, respectful manner. Mwiba actively works with this community to ensure the longevity of their tribal ways.


Driving to the general area where the nomadic tribe was last seen, you will continue on foot. Your guide and tracker will take you in search of the nomadic Hadza hunters who are moving through the wilderness. Upon finding them, you will have the opportunity to accompany them as they forage for their vital food sources. They will show you how to prod the rich African soil for tubers and stalk small mammals and hunt birds. You may even be lucky enough to witness the unique interaction between Hadza and the honey-guide bird who leads you to a hive of bees to gather wild honey!

When the heat of midday starts to hang in the air, you will retreat to the cool shade of a grove of Lerai trees where you will have the privilege of being part of story-telling time. Here the Hadza retell tales of their ancestors whilst skillfully making new bows and arrows. A tracker and guide accompany you to assist with translation. Today should be approached with an open mind and a willingness to embrace the primitive traditions of these fascinating people.

## Day 10: Friday, June 10, 2021

Mwiba Lodge, Mwiba Wildlife Reserve, Tanzania



This region is a photographer's and naturalist's paradise, with abundant elephant, buffalo, giraffe, lion and wild dog alongside huge populations of wildebeest, antelope and zebra. For those avid birders, the Reserve is also home to hundreds of bird species. Today you will continue your pursuit of the fascinating wildlife that calls this area home.

This afternoon you will have another opportunity for local cultural interaction. Driving the short distance to a traditional local village you will meet the Datoga people. The Datoga, also known as the Mang'ati, which comes from a Maasai term meaning "enemy" are a proud, fierce warrior tribe, considering themselves to be the oldest tribe in Tanzania. (Although both the Maasai and the Hadzabe will also make claim to this). They are nomadic herders, depending largely on cow and goat meat and milk for their diet. Wearing traditional red leather dress, the bracelets around their wrists and ankles create a percussive beat for their singing and dancing.

You will arrive shortly before sundown, just as the village becomes a hive of activity as the livestock and young herders return from the pastures after a day of grazing. The coolness of dusk is a relief after the heat of the day and you can feel the energy of homestead life as the people gather together and sing words of welcome in their mother tongue.

The ladies are beautifully adorned with intricate beaded necklaces and magnificent copper bangles, while the men who stand proud and tall jump and leap into the air as a ritual of Maasai / Datoga life. This experience will offer a window into how much of Africa has existed for thousands of years, and how it continues to exist today.

With only eight ensuite tents and one family tent, decor is inspired by a love of nature and raw organic materials.
